What to Bring to Day Camp

This is a nature camp, so campers will get dirty, wet, and have a great time!

What to Wear:

- Shorts or light pants, lightweight shirt, and socks and sneakers.
- Shoes must be closed-toe shoes.

Water clothes:

- Please pack water clothes **every day**.
- Water shoes must be closed-toe; nylon shorts, T shirt, and/or a bathing suit for water activities.
- Towel if desired.

Extra clothes

- Please pack a full set of extra clothes—this includes shorts, shirt, underwear, socks, and closed-toe shoes so your child can change in the event they get wet or muddy.

Sun and insect protection:

- A hat.
- Please apply insect repellent and sunscreen to your child before you arrive at camp. Please pack extra insect repellent and sunscreen for your child.
- We will avoid tall grass and contact with brush to minimize our exposure to ticks. We do daily tick checks, but you should also check your child for ticks every day at home.

Food, water:

- Pack a lunch for your child each day. We have a refrigerator for lunches.
- **Please pack a water bottle every day.** Most of our activities are outdoors on the sanctuary grounds; drinking water during the hot summer days is critical to prevent dehydration. We have a water fountain for refills.
- We will provide lemonade, water, and popcorn for an afternoon snack, or you may pack your own snack for your child.
