Important! Please read the following Contest Rules carefully before signing Registration Form:

1. The NJ Audubon/Plainsboro Preserve “Wild New Jersey” art competition is open to adult (18 years and older) residents of New Jersey only. **The artwork(s) must be the work of the person applying to the competition and depict scenes of native, indigenous wild New Jersey flora, fauna, and/or landscapes.**
2. Registration for this juried competition/show is **\$30 per artist**. Registration does not guarantee acceptance into the show. Registration fees are non-refundable.
3. Each artist may submit up to **four (4) individual pieces** for consideration. Triptychs and other multiple-piece works will be considered one piece. An individual entry must be completed for each work (see below).
4. Entry may be of any media, including photography, oils, acrylics, water color, collage, or other mixed media. **The artwork format must be flat, appropriately framed, and wired for hanging. Hanging is by a single clip to a wire. Artwork may be rejected or returned for wiring if it cannot be securely hung.** If in doubt as to the suitability of your artwork, you may call in advance to the Plainsboro Preserve (609-427-3052), or bring it in on a registration day for evaluation.
5. Each artwork must have a label with the name and contact information of the artist securely attached to the back.
6. Registration and submission of the artwork(s) must be done in person and will take place at the Plainsboro Preserve Center, 80 Scotts Corner Road, Plainsboro, NJ, on **March 15 & March 16, 2019 (10am-4pm) and March 17, 2019 (1pm-4pm)**. No registrations can be accepted any other days.
7. The submitted artwork will be evaluated by an independent panel of three jurists who will determine pieces to be included in the exhibit, and First (\$200), Second (\$150), and Third (\$100) prizes as well as up to three honorable mentions. **An additional non-monetary prize will be given for the Plainsboro Preserve Award. Works considered for this prize must specifically represent Plainsboro Preserve’s landscape, flora, or fauna.** An individual artist may only win one prize in the current year’s show.
8. **An artist may not enter a piece that they’ve already shown in a previous year in the Wild New Jersey art show.**
9. If accepted into the exhibit, it is agreed that the artwork may be photographed and that these photographs may be used by Plainsboro Preserve and New Jersey Audubon for promotional purposes.
10. Accepted art works will be displayed at Plainsboro Township Recreation Center (641 Plainsboro Road, Plainsboro, NJ) from **March 31 through April 30, 2019**, and will be open to the public during the Center’s hours of 9am-5pm daily, and during any scheduled evening events. The exhibit’s Opening Reception will be **Sunday afternoon, March 31, from 3pm–5pm**. All artwork must be available for display for the entire duration of the exhibit.
11. Artists may choose to list their works for sale. If a piece is sold during, or as a result of, this exhibit, NJ Audubon Plainsboro Preserve will be the beneficiary of 20% of the selling price, which can be considered a tax deductible donation by the artist.
12. All artwork must be picked up by the artists or a designated representative in person as follows:
 - a. Artwork not accepted into the exhibit must be picked up **by March 31, 2019 at the Plainsboro Preserve, or call to make special arrangements (609-427-3052)**.
 - b. At the close of the exhibition, all accepted and purchased artwork must be picked up between **May 2-4, 2019, 11am-4pm**, at the Plainsboro Preserve. **PLEASE DO NOT pick up artwork at the Recreation Center.**
 - c. If you are unable to pick up your artwork on these dates and times, special arrangements must be made by contacting Nancy Fiske at the Plainsboro Preserve, 609-427-3052. If artwork has not been picked up by **May 15, 2019**, and no special arrangements have been made prior to this date, artwork becomes the property of New Jersey Audubon.
