



NEW JERSEY AUDUBON SUMMER NATURE CAMP – BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

These rules are meant to ensure that all participants have a safe and enjoyable experience at NJ Audubon's camps.

- All campers will show respect for other people's ideas and values, even if they are different from their own.
- All campers will follow instructions of the summer camp teachers, counselors and other camp staff.
- All campers will respect the NJ Audubon property, wildlife and other living things.

Any behavior that could harm (physically or emotionally) a camper or staff member, or which is disrespectful, is unacceptable at NJ Audubon's camps. NJ Audubon staff will immediately notify the parent/guardian to discuss appropriate behavior goals and outline consequences. Continued inappropriate behavior or severely inappropriate behavior (such as physical or emotional violence, or bullying) will result in immediate dismissal from camp and forfeiture of camp fees.
