

New Jersey Audubon camps are State of New Jersey-certified and therefore adhere to the State of New Jersey, Department of Health policy regarding immunizations. All children attending our camps must show proof of immunization. Exemptions are accepted only for the following reasons and a written statement must accompany your child's health form.

1) Religious: A written statement from a parent/guardian indicating that "immunization interferes with the free exercise of the pupil's religious right."

2) Medical: A written statement from a physician licensed to practice medicine indicating that "an immunization is medically contraindicated for a specific period of time, and the reason(s) for the medical contraindication."
