	Handypersons: Carpentry, miscellaneous maintenance and repairs to NJA facilities. Any skill level welcomed!
	<b>Nature Store Reception and Sales</b> : Answer phone calls, complete store sales on computerized cash register, answer visitor and caller questions, fill bird feeders. We will train.
	<b>Nature Walk Leader</b> : Use your birding, botany, entomology and people skills to guide walks on center grounds and field trips. Must have birding and/or naturalist background.
	<b>NJA Center Steward, Grounds Restoration</b> : Planting and maintaining native plants on center properties and removing non-natives. Clearing occasional downed trees, grass cutting, trail maintenance, etc.
	Outreach, Fairs and Exhibits: Become an NJA Eco-Ambassador! Help us set up and operate exhibits, usually on weekends. Become knowledgeable about our programs and our mission!
