	Administrative: filing, data entry, computer work, special projects, etc
	Animal Care: Caring for animals at one of the NJ Audubon Centers
	Bird Feeders: Filling the bird feeders at one of the NJ Audubon Centers
	Birding Surveys: Collect data to further our knowledge of bird distribution and abundance in NJ. Must have experience in bird identification and be willing to commit several days for training and surveys
	Communications: copy editing, writing, graphic design, photography, etc
	Computer Data Entry: Assist with data entry supporting research and membership/donor database
	Computer Website Management and Graphic Design: Help maintain and create center website pages, create signs, posters, brochures and fliers
	Development: office work (filing, database updates, mailings), special event support (fundraising events, NJA member trips, donor events), and prospect research
	Finance: Help to manage special projects involving research and fact finding, occasional filing and admin work
	Gardening: Participate in many gardening activities such as removing non-native species (e.g. English ivy), maintaining trails around the pond, pruning shrubs and trees, planting native species around the property.
	Handy-persons: carpentry, miscellaneous maintenance and repairs to NJA facilities
	Nature Walk Leader: Use your birding, botany, entomology and people skills to guide walks on center grounds and field trips. Must have birding and/or naturalist background.
	Outreach, Fairs & Exhibits: Become an NJA Eco-Ambassador! Help us set up and operate exhibits, usually on weekends. Become knowledgeable about our programs and our mission!
	Special Events Helpers: Help to organize, set up, serve and clean up for center events.
	Summer Camp Counselor-In-Training: Leadership training opportunity designed to assist our Counselors in summer nature programs; requires minimum one-week commitment and must be entering high school or older.
