Nearly **1,100** PROGRAMS WERE CONDUCTED that reached some **20,000** CHILDREN AND ADULTS.

More than **60,000** PEOPLE VISITED OUR NATURE CENTERS, MIGRATION WATCHES, AND TRAILS.



A total of **965** ACRES of forest, grassland, agricultural land, and wetland habitat WERE RESTORED, of which **43 ACRES ARE ON PRIVATE LAND.**

New Jersey Audubon co-leads the **HORSESHOE CRAB RECOVERY COALITION**, which is in its **3RD YEAR.**

New Jersey Audubon migration watch counters logged **2,762** HOURS, tallying over **250 SPECIES** and more than **1.6 MILLION BIRDS.**

Engaged nearly **1,500** TEACHERS through professional development, who impacted more than **65,000** STUDENTS in **SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ART, and MATH (STEAM) LEARNING.**

10,000 HOURS

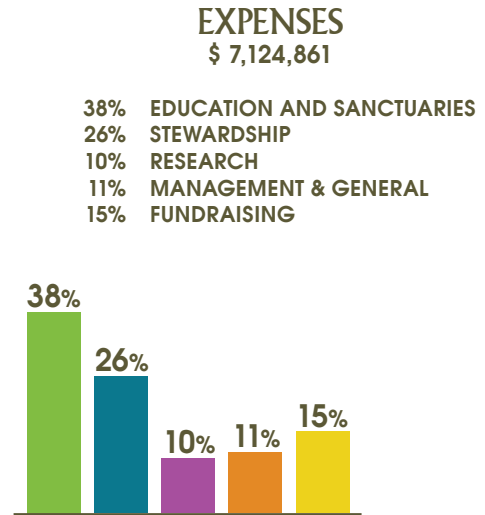
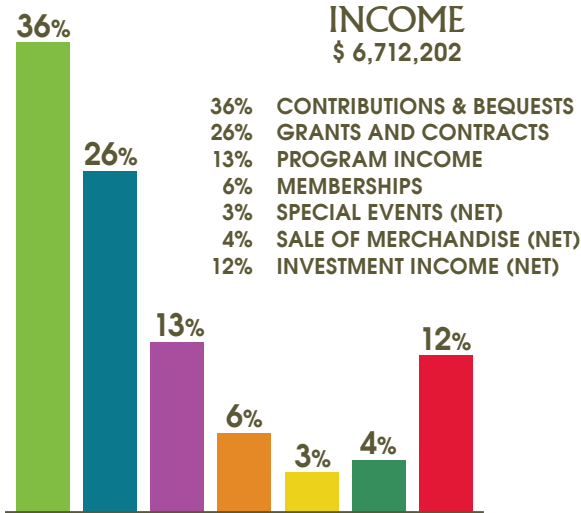
