DAY CAMPS

Entering Grades 1-3 9:00 A.M. TO 3:00 P.M. \$435/week

WATER DETECTIVES JUNE 22 TO 26

Prepare to get wet as we explore the watery habitats of the sanctuary. We'll use our detective skills to find and catch frogs, dragonfly nymphs, crayfish, and other creatures we discover.

SUMMER CAMP SAMPLER JUNE 29 TO JULY 3

Introducing a camp week with a wide variety of experiences! Each camp day will be a different topic: Forest Ecology Day, Lenape Day, Natural Art Day, Wetland Wander Day, and Things with Wings Day. Perfect for the camper who likes all things nature!

NATURAL ART JULY 6 TO 10

Bring out your inner artist as we create artwork inspired by the wildlife we discover. We'll use paints, watercolors, oil pastels, and natural materials to create art. Artwork will be displayed at the center during the week.

BUCKETS & BOOTS JULY 27 TO 31

Let's take a bucket outside and see what we can put in it! A toad, a worm, a crayfish from the stream? We'll learn about all the cool things in your bucket.

YOUNG TREASURE HUNTERS AUGUST 3 TO 7

Calling all adventurers! Look for the natural treasures of the sanctuary. We'll search for living things in their habitats, hunt for tracks, catch crayfish and frogs, and more! Find out why they're our treasures!

Everything needs a home, a safe place to shelter and raise their young. We'll learn about shelters, and search for animal homes and nests. We'll make toad homes, bee homes, bird homes and more to help our animal friends.

CATCHING CRITTERS AUGUST 17 TO 21

Take a net and jar to catch grasshoppers, butterflies, caterpillars, ladybugs, and more! Take a net and bucket and explore the pond and the river to catch tadpoles, crayfish, water striders, and more.

FISHING CAMP JUNE 22 TO 26

Join us for 5 days of fishing fun and instruction. We'll cover all the basics from gear, bait, and lures to proper fish handling and conservation ethics. We'll meet and fish at different publicly accessible ponds or streams within 15 miles of Scherman Hoffman and fish the Passaic River at the sanctuary. Bring your own gear: rod, reel, and a tackle box. Transportation not provided.

WILDERNESS SKILLS BEGINNERS - SESSION 1 JULY 6 TO 10

Learn some of the basics of wilderness survival. Learn how to set up a shelter, build a campfire, make a fishing pole and go fishing, and more. We'll end our week with cooking a snack over our campfire.

WILD WETLANDS JULY 13 TO 17

Our daily adventures at the river, pond, and other waterholes will reveal the wildlife that lives there. Learn how these plants and animals can survive in their watery habitats.

WETLAND SECRETS JULY 20 TO 24

Get your feet wet and discover the secrets of the wetlands of the sanctuary. Catch fish, frogs, crayfish, and more, and learn the secrets of surviving in watery habitats.

WILDERNESS SKILLS BEGINNERS - SESSION 2 JULY 27 TO 31

Due to its popularity, we're offering a second Beginners Session. We will be doing the same activities as in Session 1. Learn some of the basics of wilderness survival. Learn how to set up a shelter, build a campfire, make a fishing pole and go fishing, and more. We'll end our week with cooking a snack over our campfire.

FISH SCALES AND TAILS AUGUST 3 TO 7

Search for fish, frogs, salamanders, snakes, and turtles around the sanctuary. Try to catch a fish with a seine net. Meet the center's reptiles.

BUTTERFLIES AND BUDDIES AUGUST 10 - 14

We'll search the sanctuary for the largest group of animals on the Earth, the insects! With nets and buckets we'll explore the pond, river, field, and forest. We'll do daily checks of our Monarch Waystation Garden for Monarch caterpillars, and learn hands-on how to care for them.

WILDERNESS SKILLS INTERMEDIATE AUGUST 17 TO 21

This week is for campers who have completed a Scherman Hoffman Wilderness Skills or Outdoor Skills Adventure from this or a previous summer camp. This week will take outdoor skills to the next level. Activities include learning how to use found or repurposed materials to make a fire starter, tie a fly, make a hand caster, and more, and learn how to work with others in a survival situation.
